

How to Download an Audio Stream File from the fpckosciusko.org Web Site

Sometimes instead of clicking the Play button on a FPC Kosciusko Web site page that contains audio and streaming it live from the Web while connected, you might have need to download the file to your computer or device and listen to it later. Here's how to do it.

1. On fpckosciusko.org, navigate to the page that has the audio player buttons for the audio that you want to hear.
2. Find the Play button just to the right of the speaker icon as shown below.



Point to the Download link and right-click your mouse.

3. Below the Play button and speaker icon will be a link labeled "Download" as shown above. Point to the word "Download" and then right-click your mouse. When you do, you will be presented with a pop-up menu where one of your choices will be to save the file. The menu selection might say something like "Download Linked File As..." or "Save Link As..."
4. Click on the menu selection that allows you to save the file. After you do, you will be presented with a window asking you to name the file. You may leave the name already there alone if you wish or name it something more meaningful to you.
5. Before you click the Save button, look in this window to see where the file will be saved (e.g., Documents, some other folder name, or Desktop). Saving to your Desktop will allow you to find the file easily after you've saved it. After you're sure where you want to put it, click the Save button. After the file is saved, find it and double-click its icon to play it.
