Notes about the service

"So then, brothers, stand firm and hold to the traditions that you were taught by us, either by our spoken word or by our letter" (2 Thessalonians 2:15). Saying **The Apostles' Creed** helps us stand firm and hold to the teachings of the Bible. We may enter worship weary and worn-down, with weak faith. As we say the Creed, we are strengthening ourselves in the Lord our God.

What Manner of Love is a beautiful meditation on 1 John 3:1-3 that is filled with biblical allusions. Eric Alexander's profound text takes us from Christ's incarnation, through His atoning death, to the joys His work has obtained for God's beloved today and for eternity. Paul S. Jones' tune perfectly matches the text to express the awe and wonder Christians have at God's great love revealed through Christ.

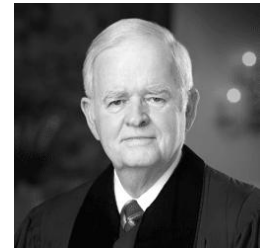

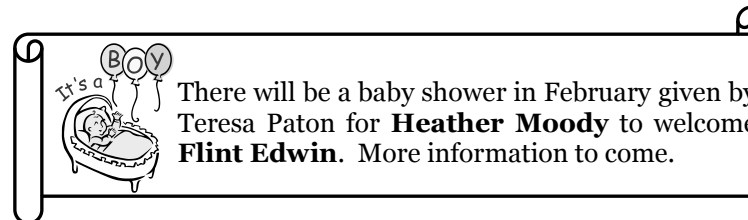

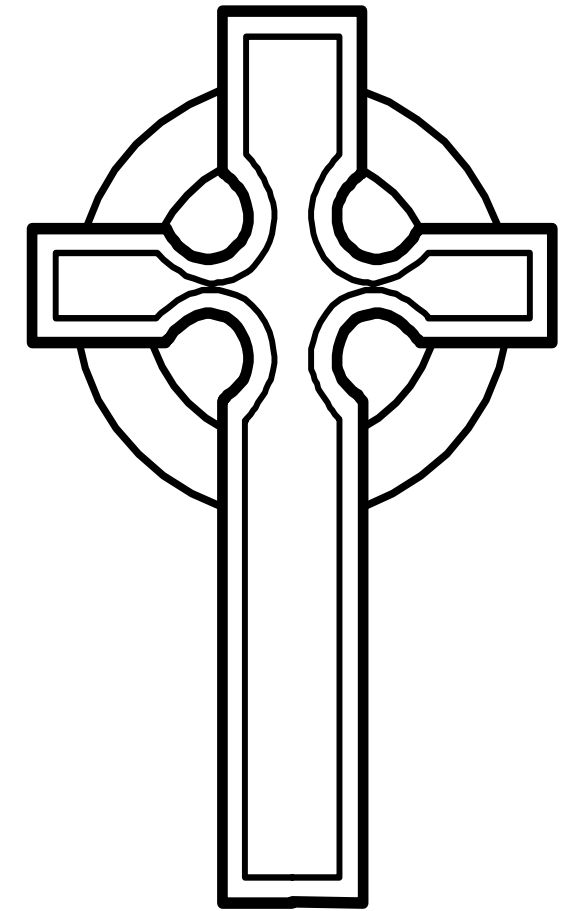
