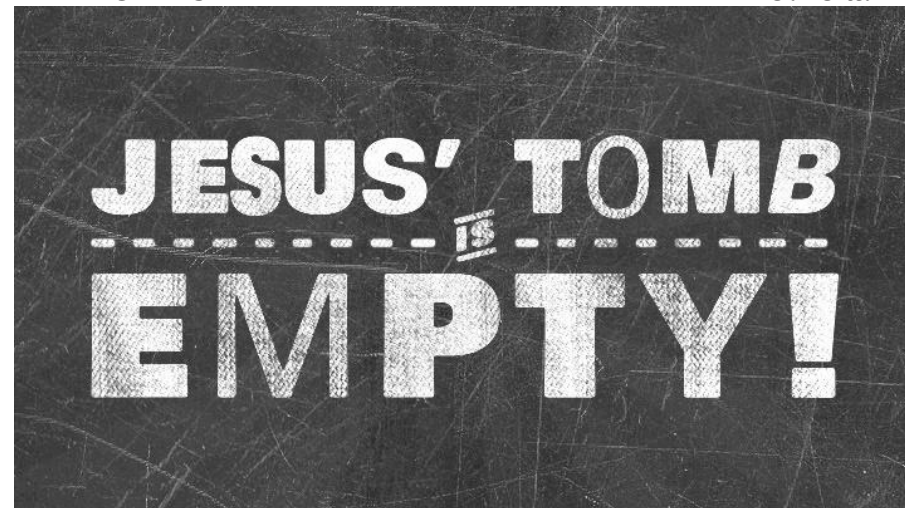

Notes about the service:

Easter: Although every Lord's Day is a celebration of the risen Christ, a special joy on Easter has been a part of the Church's worship from early times. It is an occasion to rejoice in the victory of Jesus over Satan, sin, death, the wrath of God, and hell, while also seeing lost sheep return home and lost people become Christians.

Greeting: We express our joy at the beginning of the service with the worship leader announcing: "He is risen!" and the congregation thundering back, "He is risen indeed!"

NOTE: Some of the questions submitted at the April 24 assembly can be answered in a few sentences. Such questions will be answered in the bulletin in upcoming weeks.

Q. How does a fund become "designated?"

A. A fund becomes "designated" by an act of the Session. "Designated" funds are created by the Session for specific purposes or special short-term projects outside the regular operating budget. For example, if funds are being raised for an upcoming mission trip, Session may create a "Designated Special Fund" to track giving and fund-raising, as well as expenditures related to that trip. Other examples would be Faith Promise, scholarship giving for students at PDS and, and special offerings for our annual World Mission Conference and Bible Conference expenses.

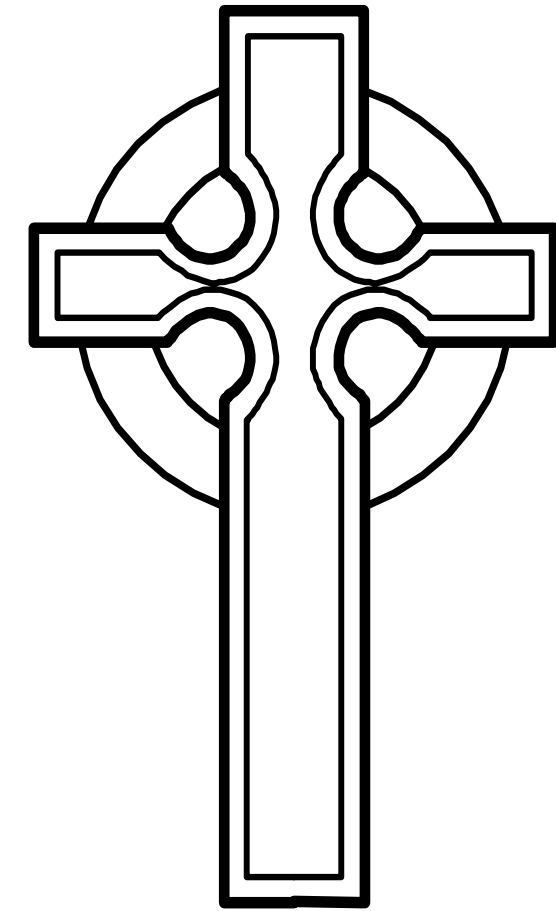
