### Notes about the service:

"This word of God is everywhere in worship. In the call to worship we hear God's first word to us; in the benediction we hear God's last word to us; in the Scripture lessons we hear God speaking to our faith-parents; in the sermon we hear that word re-expressed to us; in the hymns, which are all to a greater or lesser extent paraphrases of Scripture, the Word of God makes our prayer articulate. Every time we worship our minds are informed, our memories refreshed with the judgments of God, we are familiarized with what God says, what he has decided, the ways he is working out our salvation." **Confession of Sin:** "All those who are distressed because of their sins and sense themselves to be under God's wrath...are on the highway to grace and favour. God justifies only those who repent; he exalts only those who are humbled; he comforts none but the distressed; he has mercy only on those who both know and feel they lack it, and who also know that there is nowhere else to receive it except at his hands. 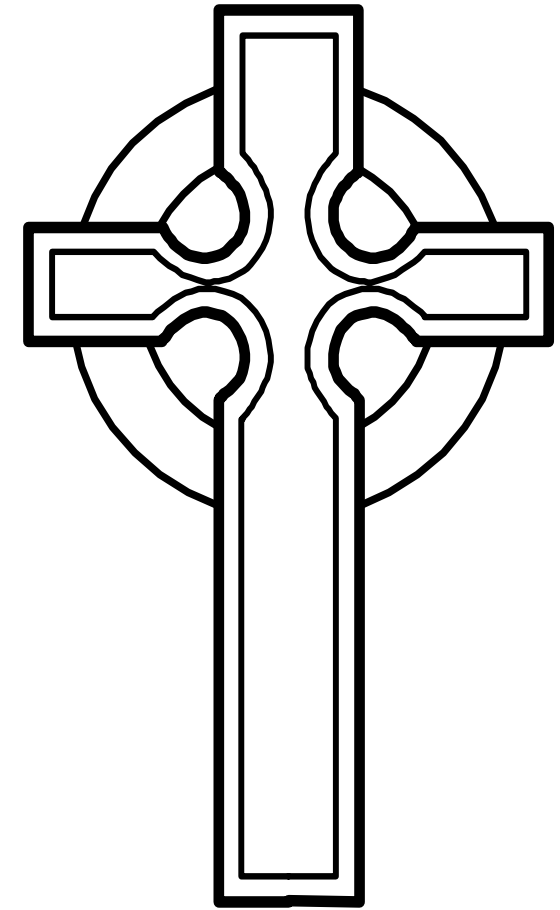
