### Notes about the service:

**The Lord's Supper:** First, the Lord's Supper is a **communion**, not only between a believer and Christ, but also with his people. This means that we should not come to the Lord's Table with wrong attitudes towards other believers.

Second, the Lord's Supper is a **confession** of our sinfulness, of Christ's sufficiency, of our union with him, and of our longing for heaven.

Third, the Lord's Supper is a **means of grace**. We believe that Jesus intends to nourish, strengthen, and comfort us when we come to his Table.

Fourth, the Lord's Supper is a sign of **commitment**. By coming to it, we reaffirm our determination to continue following Jesus by committing ourselves to the life of the local church and to living for Jesus day by day in the community, in the workplace, in the family, and everywhere.

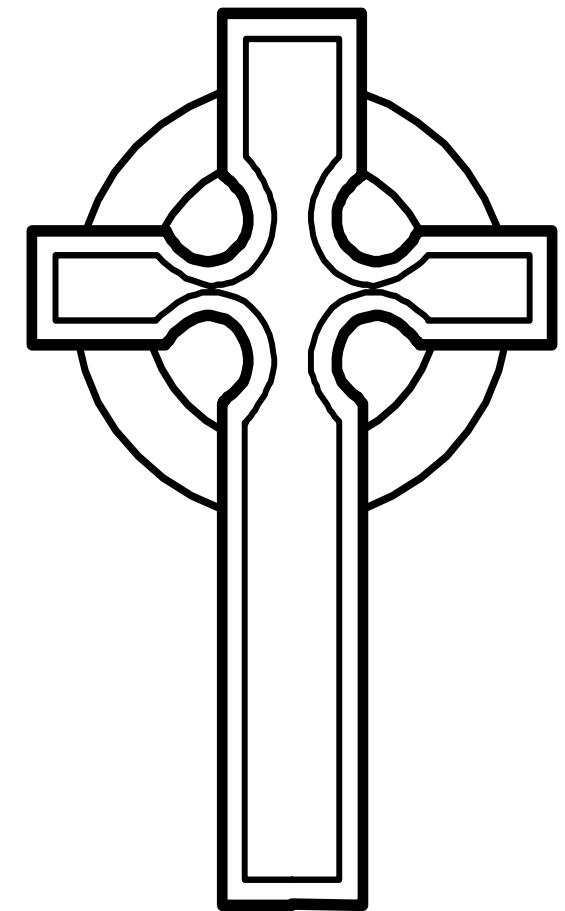
