PCA Ministerial Relief Christmas Offering

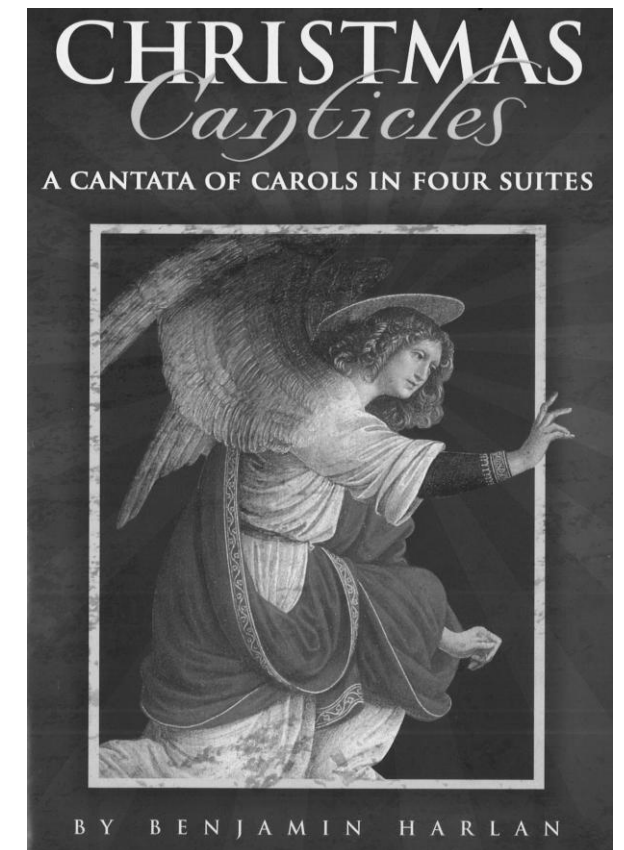

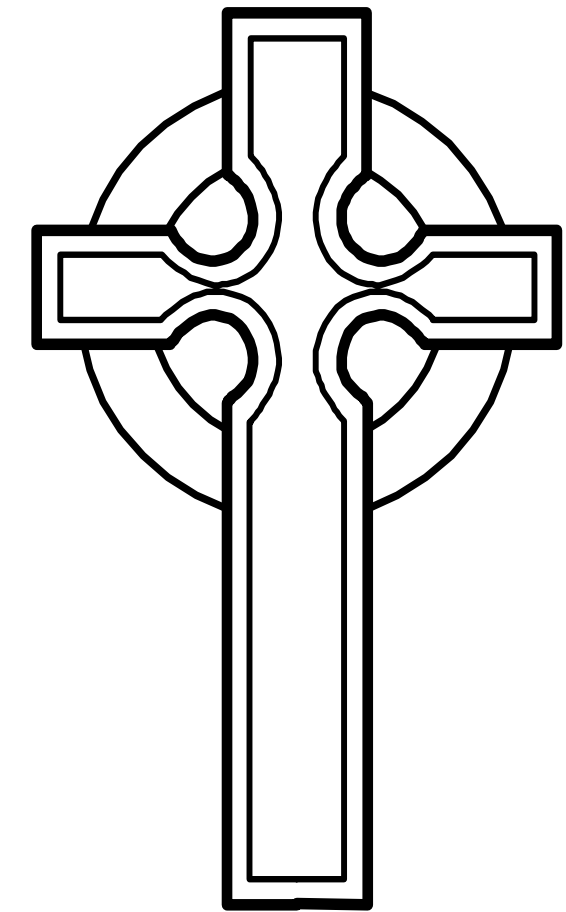
