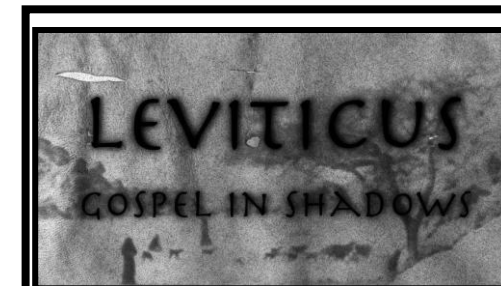


FPC Choir and Prime-Timers: Vienna Boys' Choir concert Thursday, March 1

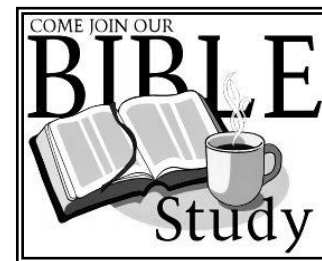

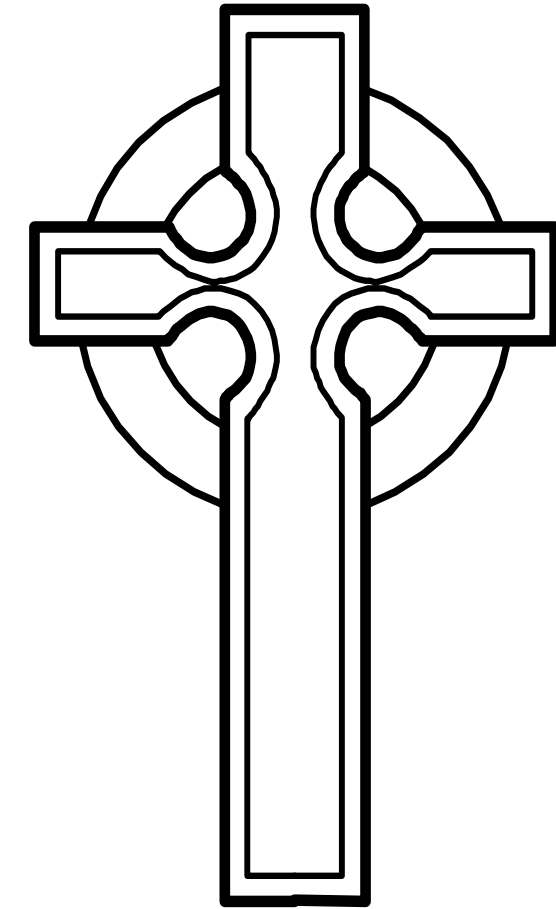
